# ALASKA MIGRANT EDUCATION PROGRAM

## **CHILD ELIGIBILITY**

A child *may* qualify for the program if:
Out of economic necessity, the family traveled to engage in fishing (commercial, subsistence, or processing), subsistence berry picking, commercial logging, or agricultural work for at least a total of 7 nights / 8 days.

Note: There are many ways a child may qualify for the Migrant Education Program. Contact your school district if anyone in your family engages in these types of activities!

## **HOW TO ENROLL**

Contact your school district!

A trained recruiter will interview you to determine if your children could be eligible for the program.

## **PROGRAM SERVICES**

Services vary by school district.
The program provides instructional and support services that help migratory children succeed in school and graduate high school prepared for responsible citizenship, further learning, and productive employment.
